Lisa Karrer's "Schismism: Natural Law" is a solo performance inspired by the life of Charles Darwin, in collaboration with composer/musician **David Simons**. In "Schismism" Karrer's solo voice is featured with arresting sonic and visual backdrops, acoustic and electronic compositions, and features an interwoven collection of stories, visual associations and musical concepts that mirrors Darwin's exploration of evolution and universal connectedness.

Lisa shares the evening with keynote speaker **Dr. Francisco Ayala**, a renowned evolutionary biologist and geneticist. He currently conducts research at University of California, Irvine where he focuses on population and evolutionary genetics, the origin of species, and molecular clocks of evolution. Dr. Ayala has written several books on the intersection of evolution and religion, including Darwin's Gift to Science and Religion, and Darwin and Intelligent Design.
